The Town of North Hempstead Town Clerk's Office is designated as an official U.S. Passport Acceptance Center by the United States Department of State. Anyone traveling outside the U.S. by air, including children and infants, is required to have a passport. At the Town Clerk's Office, we accept and process passport applications daily until 3:00pm. We have applications available for your convenience and are happy to answer any
