GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Assists in providing veterinary medical services at a municipal animal shelter under the supervision of a licensed Veterinarian; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, the duties require the exercise of considerable judgment in assisting in providing veterinary medical services at a municipal animal shelter.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 2. Assists in diagnosing and treating sick and injured animals.
- 3. Assists in the performance of complex medical and surgical procedures as necessary, including but not limited to spaying, neutering, vaccination, and euthanasia.
