SUPPLY & INSTALLATION OF EXTERIOR STOREFRONT LIGHTING FOR PRIVATE COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS

1. INTRODUCTION:

The Town of North Hempstead Community Development Agency ("TNHCDA") is conducting a storefront improvement program to assist private commercial building owners. This Request for Proposal (RFP) is specifically for quotes for work to be expedited on Westbury Avenue, Carle Place, NY. The TNHCDA engaged Vision Accomplished ("VA") to administer the program and now seeks your proposal for items as referenced below. This RFP does not seek quotes from a general contractor who will subcontract particular trades. Rather, we request proposals from trade professionals to form a contract directly with the TNHCDA. The contract will require your responsiveness to project schedules, needs of property owners and coordination with other assigned trade professionals and contractors.

Upon agreement with qualified building owners, TNHCDA will order and pay for approved professional crafting and installation of specific storefront improvements. The focal point is to harmoniously improve aesthetics with quality signs, lights and/or awnings in this business district.

We seek your proposal to supply and install, new/approved exterior storefront lighting fixtures, as directed, in a timely manner on specific commercial storefronts. Municipal requirements, permits, insurance and public policies apply so please note your experience. If awarded, you contract with TNHCDA to perform services on one or more buildings, as assigned. This may lead to the potential continuation of orders to follow, contingent on satisfactory performance and available funding. This contract is not exclusive so based on planning, need for expediency and other considerations, the TNHCDA will likely award more than one professional contract for on call assignments, as needed. If mutually agreed upon, the TNHCDA may award work on other projects as well.

The TNHCDA intends to select the most favorable offers and needs to begin approved projects speedily to fully conclude the project by mid-February 2025. The TNHCDA expects that, upon notice of your award, you will acquire all known necessary materials and supplies needed for delivery with knowledge that your installation of approved façade improvements is expected to commence and continue, as weather permits, from as early as this December through February 2025.

2. INFORMATION FOR PROPOSERS:

Here is how this project and proposal works: You submit pricing on standard materials and sizes, as requested. Unless stated otherwise, equipment is specified. So, while it may be possible, not probable, to later substitute (with written approval) your proposal should not now substitute. If you cannot supply what is specified, indicate the same and skip that portion of your quotation. If any line is blank, we will insert the highest price quoted by another for that line in your proposal, plus 5% contingency.

For purposes of this proposal and to enable work to begin shortly, we provide "Exhibit C" sample conceptual renderings of some anticipated storefront renewals. Once ready, the TNHCDA will acquire permission from building owners to commence work thereon. Be advised that while these building owners & tenants have expressed desire to participate, required agreements have not yet been formed. Moreover, the attached sample improvements have not been discussed with applicable building owners and are subject to change. Do not consider these as work orders.

4. PROPOSAL SUBMISSION:

To be considered for this program submit to TNHCDA and VA at minimum, the following information and documentation:

If you prefer, you can fill out our <u>TNCCDA Contractor Prequalification Application</u>. You are welcome to submit pictures or samples of your work.
- b) <u>Town Sign Erectors License</u>: To install an lighting you must have or apply for a Town Sign Erectors license. Click here for further information <u>Town of North Hempstead Sign Erector's License</u>. Please advise of your status as a Town Sign Erector or intention/proof of application.
- c) Submit and complete Appendix A: This includes 1. Statement of Understanding, Disclosure Form, and Non-Collusive Proposal Certification.
- d) <u>Pricing</u>: Submit complete copy of this RFP along with "Contractor **PRICING SHEET** Exhibit B" of this RFP.
- e) <u>Date and Time for Submitting your Proposal</u>: We are accepting proposals on an ongoing basis. However, we intend to award initial contracts and will review submissions based on proposals submitted on or before November 29, 2024 at 2:30 pm.

f) <u>Submitting a TNHCDA Prequalification Application</u>: The TNHCDA is receiving applications on an ongoing basis, so a specific date and time for submitting a Prequalification Application is not required. But don't wait. Several new projects will be coming online soon, and we look forward to forging new partnerships.

5. EVALUATION OF PROPOSALS:

TNHCDA and VA will evaluate each proposal with emphasis on the following factors:

- a) Demonstrated successful, relevant experience on other projects of comparable value and scope.
- b) Accessibility to project areas and availability to expedite services.

6. RIGHT OF REJECTION BY TNHCDA:

TNHCDA and VA reserves the right to select respondents to this RFP who best meet the requirements of the RFP. TNHCDA and VA reserve the right, for any or no reason and in its sole and absolute discretion, to (1) amend, in whole or part, this RFP, (2) withdraw or cancel this RFP, (3) accept any or all bids in whole or in part, (4) award agreements to one or more than one respondent, and (5) accept or reject any or all bids prior to or after opening proposals for any or no reason and with no penalty to the TNHCDA.

7. NOTICE OF AWARD:

A selected contractor will be notified they have been selected by digital notice or in writing. Neither the Contractor's approval nor the issuance of notice shall constitute a binding commitment to enter a contract with a Contractor, as any binding arrangement must be through a negotiated and fully executed contract ("Contract") with the TNHCDA. After a Contract is fully executed, the TNHCDA or VA will assign work through Work Orders approved by TNHCDA as funder.

Exhibit B - PRICING SHEET Supply and Installation of Custom Wall Lighting

A. <u>Prerequisite Standards to Assume For Supply and Install of Lighting as Preparation For Quotes</u>

Pricing below is to supply, install and service lighting equipment noted, understanding that lighting install will be coordinated to occur soon after new wall signs are installed and prior to installation of façade awnings where the same is also ordered. Placement of sign lights, will be case-by-case based on available space at site and details of custom lettering on sign to be illuminated. Gooseneck sign lights are generally set 6"- 1' above each sign with illumination spread at 2.5' to 3' apart to focus on lettering and logos.

Pricing to include: LED fixtures; an automatic *Dawn-Dusk* activation for each storefront; supply of an electrical box and time clock. Assume average installation with a power source within 10' of location of installation:

Note that along with an approved work order for specifics, you will be guided by either an artistic rendering that depicts the particular recommended façade improvement, without elevations. Or you will see a similarly sized/situated storefront that will guide you to replicate lighting with different storefront exterior dimensions or features. You must measure and set proper elevation for the location's lighting while considering coordination and placement consistent with other installations of signs and awnings. Sign lighting generally anticipated to spread illumination slightly beyond all words or images in the sign below. Coordination of trade schedules will be conducted through *Vision Accomplished* or TNHCDA.


Lighting


Westbury Avenue has a more active retail character to the east and a more business-oriented character to the west. Therefore, these lighting options suggest two design approaches: historic/traditional and comtemporary design. Either could be used for part or the whole length of Westbury Avenue.

Additionally, sign lighting may be eye-brow can lights installed beneath the soffit where traditional gooseneck lighting cannot be done. Moreover, there may be occasions when the electrician must connect a feed left by a sign-maker on site, to the appropriate electrical power box. Coordination with sign maker and project manager will be necessary if that were to occur. TNHCDA foresees that if that were to occur, it will be very infrequent. If needed, prior approval from project manager is necessary and a gooseneck light install fee will be allowed.



Gooseneck Sign Light Options - Westbury Ave., Carle Place






