Dear PSEG Long Island customer:

In the coming weeks, the Town of North Hempstead will be moving forward with its Port Washington Streetscape Project. To accommodate the Town of North Hempstead's plans for this area, PSEG Long Island will trim trees along an electric distribution circuit that coincides with the location of this project.

Project Specifics

PSEG Long Island's vegetation management program reduces the number of power outages by trimming branches away from electric wires. Outages caused by trees have decreased, on average, by 60 percent in areas we've trimmed. (Even if your home's electric service is underground, overhead lines are part of the distribution system that supplies your power, and you will benefit from this maintenance / improvement.)

What is the timeline for the tree trimming?

Crews will begin work in late August/early September and the work will last approximately two weeks.

What are the work hours?

Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Will there be any power outages?

We do not anticipate any power outages related to this work.

Will there be any traffic interruptions?

There may be minor traffic and parking disruptions while the work is performed. To ensure traffic moves safely, PSEG Long Island will provide cones, flagmen and signage at the work sites, as needed.
