Help at Home will be provided by TRI workers, supervised by their job coaches, to Town residents age 60 and over.

There is no charge for the service, but the homeowner/renter must pay for or provide any supplies needed.

PLEASE NOTE-This is a training program and can only be used three times a year at most, and due to high demand there is a waiting period for service.
