## OUTREACH BUS COVID 19 PLAN

Bus will park in assigned spot in parking lot. The interior of the bus will remain clean and sanitized with social distance protocols. Weather permitting screenings will take place under the awning.

All staff and patients will be required to wear a mask. Staff will wear gloves throughout the screening. Nurses will use a new pair of gloves for each patient.

Two chairs will be placed under awning with backs to each other, 6 feet apart. If it is raining or if it is too hot, arrangements will be made with site to use a large open room for screenings and education. If no such space is available, site will be rescheduled.

Patients will be expected to clean hands with hand sanitizer prior to screening.

Patients will be asked COVID 19 screening questions and temperature will be checked using an Infrared thermometer. Patients will be denied screening if they report significant COVID-19 exposure or symptoms during the prior 14 days or have a temperature equal to or greater than 100.0° Fahrenheit.

After temperature is checked, screening will take place and education and referrals provided as needed. Patients will receive results immediately.

Chairs and equipment will be cleaned with germicidal wipes between patients.
